The Patrol Leader Training Unit (PLTU) courses are one of the finest challenges on the South African Scouting calendar. Exciting outdoor activities support the specialised leadership training you will receive during ten tough but achievement filled days.

To date, the Weston Patrol Leader Training Unit has trained over one thousand seven hundred candidates, who have benefited from the high staff to participant ratio.

The courses are staffed by fellow Scouts and Scouters, most of whom who have previously risen to the PLTU challenge. Course: 46th Weston PLTU
